- 0630** All hands report aboard for Muster at Moreland Mess Hall.
- 0645** Morning chow.
- 0730** Muster outside Mess Hall; MAA's check for gear adrift.
- 0745** Report to New facility (Building 1251), in preparation for Annual Inspection.
- 0750** Set Quarterdeck Watch. (ALPO make sure cadets on QD are fully prepared for Inspection)
- 0800** All hands prepare for Annual Inspection: Uniform & Knowledge Preparation. (Lead by LPO/CPO's/MAA's)
- 0830** All hands welcome Regional Director LCDR Sid Willis and Regional Staff aboard. Quarterdeck, Side boys assume duties, Color Guard parades the colors.
- 0900** Uniform Inspection; Conducted by LCDR Willis.
- 1000** Secure Personnel Inspection; Color Guard parades the colors.
- 1010** Head/stretch break.
- 1020** Report back to formation; LPO/ALPO discuss the Plan of the Day with Squadron.
- 1045** Depart for Moreland Mess Hall.
- 1055** Muster at Moreland Mess Hall.
- 1100** Afternoon Chow.
- 1200** Muster outside Mess Hall; MAA's check for gear adrift.
- 1205** Depart for Building 1251.
- 1215** Arrive at Building 1251; Prepare for Classroom Instruction.
- 1230** Classroom Instruction on USS Forrester with CPO Diltz.
- 1330** Prepare to depart for OJT Activities.
- 1345** OJT's split accordingly.
- 1500** Secure all OJT Activities; Report back to Building 1251.
- 1515** Classroom Instruction on the U.S. Coast Guard with PO1 Griffin.
- 1615** Secure Classroom Instruction.
- 1620** Squadron Meeting; Discussion on next drill, housekeeping, etc.
- 1700** Secure drill; all hands dismissed.

- * **Duty MAA's:** All MAA's will be on duty, as previously discussed.
- * **OOD:** INST Gould
- * **Color Guard:** PO3 Dampf, PO3 Gould, PO3 Kilgore, and SN Dickerson.
- * **Side-boys:** LC1 Erickson, LC3 Greene, LC1 Coulter, LC1 Quattlebaum, LC1 Gordon, LC2 Fuentes.

Important Things:

- * **Uniforms:** Make sure your dress uniforms are 250%, and PLEASE brush up on your knowledge (ex: Sailor's Creed, General Order, Officer/Enlisted Ranks, college/career plans, etc.)
- * **One Day Drill:** Note that this drill is only a one day, due to Annual Inspection. Be sure to plan accordingly.
- * **Corpsman:** Be sure to bring the medical backpack.
- * **MAA's:** Brush up on your uniform regulations; you will be assisting in the "Mock Inspection" during preparation time. You will document all gigs and help correct them.
- * **Muster:** As always, allow extra time for the front gate. DO NOT BE LATE.
- * **Cadet Processing:** Make sure you show up to morning muster with your drill fee, ID card, and a copy of the POD.
- * **PRT:** March drill is the Annual Physical Readiness Test (PT Test). Be sure to prepare for that next month.
- * **Report Cards:** Please bring your most recent report cards to turn in. We would like to see some more Academic Achievement ribbons awarded!
